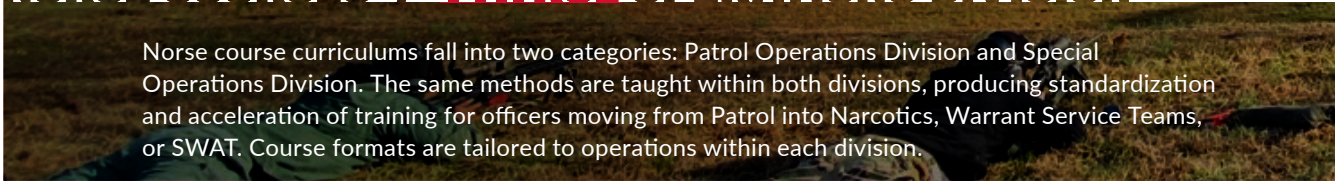


Norse's national presence has allowed the organization to build its training programs specifically to fit their departmental/agency needs.

Each of our programs are built on principles which provide officers the opportunity to process information without compromising tactical advantage.

Norse's ability to standardize their principle based system for special operations and patrol has been the biggest paradigm shift in Law Enforcement training culture throughout the country.

Our constant analysis of current trends in law enforcement, coupled with expansive information sharing has also allowed our clients to expand their knowledge base on the applicability of the Norse System to their specific area of operation.



Norse course curriculums fall into two categories: Patrol Operations Division and Special Operations Division. The same methods are taught within both divisions, producing standardization and acceleration of training for officers moving from Patrol into Narcotics, Warrant Service Teams, or SWAT. Course formats are tailored to operations within each division.

TACTICAL FIREARMS COURSES

LVL I – This 1-day course teaches the fundamentals for safe weapons manipulation, accurate target engagement, malfunction mitigation, and weapon transitions and techniques for effective weapon employment in restrictive environments, utilizing the Pistol and Patrol Rifle systems.

LVL II – This 1-day course will challenge students’ proficiency with Pistol and Rifle systems, demanding increased levels of accuracy during complex exercises. Dynamic exercises will require students to move to and from cover and engage targets while maintaining a high degree of safety, accuracy, and situational awareness.

LVL III – This 1-day course will introduce students to the most rigorous requirements for the ability to positively identify and accurately engage targets, maintain stringent discipline for safety protocols, and work cooperatively with other officers within restrictive environments.

TACTICAL PATROL OFFICER COURSES

LVL I – This 3-day course will instruct students on the fundamentals of accurate target engagement with a pistol and skills critical for safe, effective weapons techniques within close quarters environments. Students will learn effective technique to enter and clear a structure as a 2-officer element in a controlled and effective manner.

LVL II - This 3-day course will build upon the level I course, implementing the Patrol Rifle. Students will learn to utilize pistol and rifle platforms in Close Quarters environments and the fundamentals for accurate and safe engagement principles for both systems.

LVL III – This 3-Day course will build upon the fundamentals of firearms with the Pistol and Patrol Rifle platforms. Entry and Clearance fundamentals and techniques, utilizing both weapon systems, as part of a 2-4 officer element will produce a student with an enhanced capacity to respond to increased threat situations.



BREACHER COURSES

Breacher 101 – This 1-Day course will enable the officer to properly utilize a Battering Ram, Sledgehammer, or Halligan Tool to defeat a locked or barricaded door. Officers will understand how to select and implement the proper tool, and defeat the door while maintaining the highest degree of officer safety through proper positioning.

VEHICLE COURSES

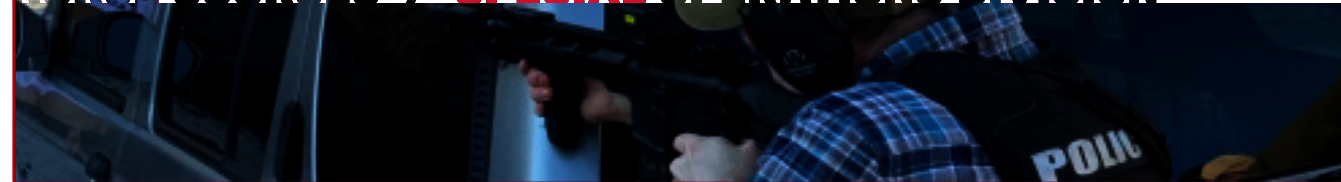
Vehicle Engagements – This 1-Day course will provide the student with an understanding of the considerations necessary in the event that an engagement occurs involving firing into or out of a vehicle. Principles of cover and concealment, along with benefits and deficiencies of the barriers created by materials of a vehicle will be understood.

SPECIALIZED COURSES

Officer Recovery Course – This 3-Day Course will instruct officers on techniques to successfully facilitate the recovery of a downed officer at a scene. Officers will be put through multiple scenarios in which they will mitigate and suppress an existing threat, move into position, and transport an officer to a position in which they are able to be treated or evacuated.

Low Light Pistol – This 1-Day Course will teach officers utilization of both Weapon- Mounted and Hand-Held light systems for operational use in conjunction with their service pistol. Operation of both light system types while engaging with a pistol, as well as utilization during non-lethal but elevated-risk situations are demonstrated and practiced.

MRDS Pistol - This 2-Day Course will teach officers the specific considerations and techniques to employ a Pistol that is equipped with an MRDS (Miniature Red Dot Sight) System. Specific techniques that will maximize effectiveness with the MRDS system will ensure accuracy and efficiency.



CLOSE QUARTERS TACTICS COURSES

LVL I – This 3-Day course will teach the student the fundamentals of clearing structures utilizing a system focusing on 2 and 4 officer elements, as part of a larger team. The Norse Variable Threat system establishes principles and fundamentals that enable officers to clear structures of varying configurations regardless of the operation profile.

LVL II – This 3-Day curriculum prepares the student to clear structures with increased complexity, as a small element, to include multiple elements operating simultaneously within a structure. Students will be able to produce the highest degree effectiveness, without sacrificing officer safety.

LVL III – This 3-Day course instructs students on the methods required to operate at the highest operative tempo within the most austere conditions, without sacrificing effectiveness. Students will be required to complete scenarios involving high threat circumstances, including Hostage Rescue scenarios, while maintaining an increased level of officer safety.

SWAT COURSES

LVL I – This 5-Day course will provide a SWAT, or equivalent officer, with the fundamental critical skills necessary for tactical operations. One day of Pistol / Rifle Training, one day of Mechanical Breaching, and three days of Close Quarters Entry techniques will enhance the skills of experienced officers and prepare new officers for real-world operations.

LVL II – This 5-Day course will enhance the officer's skills to prepare for increased threat level response. Featuring dynamic live fire exercises, mechanical breaching techniques for challenging positions and situations, as well as, advanced techniques for Close Quarters Tactics. This course will enhance the capacity of any SWAT officer to better address elevated threats in less than desirable circumstances.

LVL III – This 5-Day course will challenge officers to perform at the highest level. Range exercises will require elevated levels of discipline, accuracy, and awareness. Vehicle Interdiction techniques will ensure that high risk stops are executed with high levels of precision and officer safety. Close Quarters Tactics methods necessary for lifesaving operations under least favorable conditions will produce an officer capable of responding to the most adverse circumstances with favorable outcomes.



BREACHER COURSES

Breacher 201 – This 1-Day Course will instruct the Breacher to defeat eccentric problems with the core mechanical tool systems. Scenarios that restrict movement and present unfavorable positions for the breacher and the entry team will be focused on. Alternate methods for entry team movement and breacher operation and employment of tools will be a key element.

Explosive Breacher Course – This 5-Day Course will instruct students on the elements of safely calculating, constructing, and employing explosive breach charges. Students will be able to properly plan and execute an explosive breach, to include maintaining the safety of the entry team over the entire course of action, from planning to execution.

PRECISION RIFLE COURSES

Precision Rifle Course I – This 5-Day Course will instruct students to properly perform the duties of a LE Sniper/Observer. Students will have a detailed understanding of setting up their weapon system and compiling the most accurate data to support a precision engagement under stressful conditions. Techniques to ensure accurate ballistic data, corrections for environmental factors, and positive target identification will ensure precision capability for the student.

Precision Rifle Course II – This 5-Day Course will expand the capabilities of the Sniper/ Observer. Students will be able to calculate corrections for moving targets, and effects and corrections for material barriers. Students will be proficient in shooting from alternate positions under adverse conditions while maintaining positive target identification and precise shot placement.

VEHICLE COURSES

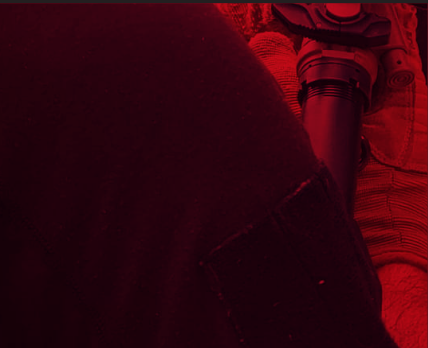
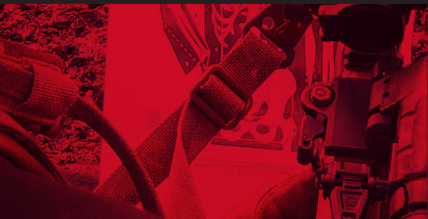
Vehicle Interdiction – This 1-day course will instruct students in proper methods for a high- risk vehicle stop. Students will learn proper methods for approach, security posture, and extraction. Multiple Vehicle Platforms ranging from a passenger vehicle, large SUV, and commercial vehicles will be utilized for practical exercises. Students will understand the individual techniques as well as overall considerations for a team element.

THE NORSE PORTAL

Norse clients understand the success that comes with systematized and standardized training. Training time is a precious commodity for Law Enforcement Officers and the agencies that they represent. Advanced training requires more time spent in formal courses to achieve quality results and more time spent post formal course time to ensure proficiency.

Students attending Norse courses utilize the Portal as an essential part of the course. Communication between students and from students to instructors in conjunction with instructional video segments of course content produce exceptional levels of proficiency and retention of course content.

Students who become subscribing members of the Portal have continuous access to these resources. The value of training is much greater if the student is able to retain the information with a high level of proficiency. Skillsets which do not get utilized and practiced on a daily basis will consistently diminish. These skillsets are often those that are necessary in an immediate manner within a critical situation.
