Night Vision Operator Course

The Night Vision Operator Course Special Operations Officers.

Students should attend the course wearing the uniform along with the equipment and weapon systems that they would in their specific role. All department standard or mandated equipment to include ballistic protection for live fire training.

It is recommended to bring items suited for seasonal or inclement weather.

- o Rifle 500 Rounds (Department Approved Training Ammunition)

Non-Lethal Marking Ammuntion: Per Officer

- o Pistol 50 Rounds

- 3 Magazines for Each Weapon System (Minimum)
- Gun Belt with Standard Tactical Loadout.
- Eye Protection

- Batteries for All Devices
